Art Effect

Format and Rules

- 1. Two delegates per delegation can take part in this category.
- 2. The category will take place **over** two days, and participants will be allocated 3 hours on Day 1 and 3 hours on Day 2, having a total of **six** hours in the category
- 3. Participants have the freedom to choose any medium such as colored pencils, acrylic **paints**, watercolors, etc.
- 4. Participants are responsible for bringing their own materials such as paint, stationery, brushes, water containers, charcoal, acrylic paint, etc.
 - The host school will provide A3 drawing paper.
 - The artwork should not display **any** offensive material, including profanity, hate speech, etc.

Judging Criteria

Composition and Balance: Delegates will be judged based on their attention to the placement and balance of the objects and emphasis will be on achieving a composition that guides **the** viewer's eye smoothly and evokes an emotional **impact**.

Harmony and Proportion: How well are the **elements** balanced within **the** frame? Does the composition evoke **a** sense of harmony and proportion?

Use of Medium: Judges will assess how effectively participants utilize their chosen medium to bring out the textures, colors, and details of the still-life objects.

Technical Skill: Delegates will be judged based on their attention to precision and accuracy in capturing the forms and nuances of the still-life items.

Creativity and Originality: How effectively does the composition reflect the unique style and creativity of the artist? Delegates will be evaluated based on their ability to infuse originality and creativity while showcasing their unique perspective into their still-life composition

Format and Rules

- 1. Each delegation can have up to three students participate
- 2. Participants are expected to bring in their own DSLR cameras or a good quality smartphone.
- Pictures will be taken on Day 1 and Day 2. At the end of Day 2, participants will print their best three photographs in the size 16x20 inches.
- 4. The pictures will be the property of the Melange Team and can not be used by the participants on any social media platform
- 5. The picture will be judged on its originality, composition and effective reportage

Format and Rules

- 1. Time duration must not be shorter than 12 minutes and no longer than 15 minutes
- 2. Each delegation must submit a copy of the script one week prior to the event
- 3. Each delegation may not have more than 8 members, with each actor in a costume
- 4. All lines and dialogues must be memorized by the actors
- 5. A narrator is required to present the context of the scenes
- 6. One song performance to a pre-recorded song or through live singing is recommended

- Creativity
- Adherence to chosen time setting
- Acting skills
- Costume design
- Overall presentation

- 4. Teams must bring typed copies of their dish recipes on the day of the competition
- 5. Each team must follow the theme of "holiday feast" in their dishes.
- 6. Each team will be given 2.5 hours to prepare and present their dishes
- 7. Each team will be provided with a hob, an oven, running water and working counters.
- 8. Each team must bring the following for use if required:
 - All ingredients
 - Appliances if needed
