# Melange 2.0

Study Guide | Sports

#### **Futsal [Boys]**

- 1. Each team will consist of 8 players, including the goalkeeper (5 players 3 substitutes)
- 2. Trainers/Gripper and shin pads should be worn; cleats will not be allowed.
- 3. Each match will be 20 minutes, while the semi finals and finals will be 30 minutes each.
- 4. No player will be allowed on the pitch without a proper school kit.
- 5. Referee's decision will be considered final.
- 6. Discontentment towards the referee and abusive language will lead to a yellow card.
- 7. In case of a red card, the player is bound to leave the pitch and will not be eligible to play for the rest of the match.
- 8. Teams must report 15 minutes prior to the venue. If any team fails to show up within 10 minutes after the allotted time of their match, a walkover will be given.



#### **TABLE TENNIS [Boys/Girls]**

- 1. Boys & Girls singles matches will be conducted.
- 2. Each match shall consist of 3 sets of 11 points each.
- 3. If a player/team wins the first 2 sets, the 3rd set will not be played.
- 4. The serve will be decided through a serve toss
- 5. Players must report 15 minutes prior to the venue. If any player fails to show up within 10 minutes after the allotted time of their match, a walkover will be given.
- 6. Each player serves two points in a row before the serve is changed
- 7. The ball must be tossed straight upwards to at least six inches while serving
- 8. All other standard table tennis rules will be followed



### **BASKETBALL** [Boys/Girls]

- 1. Each Team will consist of 8 players (5 players and 3 substitutes).
- 2. Each match will be 20 minutes long with four 5-minute quarters.
- 3. The 24 second and 8 second shot clock will be used during the game. Fouls like the defensive and offensive 3 seconds, 5 second back to the basket, traveling, double dribble, backcourt violation, goaltending, charges, blocking, flagrant and technical fouls will be counted.
- 4. The semi-final and final will be 40 minutes long with four 10-minute quarters.
- 5. If a player commits 6 fouls, they will be ejected from the game and will not be able to return during the match.
- 6. Players must report 15 minutes prior to the venue. If any player fails to show up within 15 minutes after the allotted time of their match, a walkover will be given.



## **Badminton** [Boys/Girls]

- 1. Singles will be conducted
- 2. Each match consists of 3 sets of 11 points each. If a player wins the first 2 sets, the 3rd set will not be played
- 3. Referee's decision will be final
- 4. Standard badminton rules will be followed
- 5. Coin toss will be carried out to determine the first serve
- 6. Serve will only be played after referees whistle
- 7. Serve must carry cross court (diagonally) in order to be legal
- 8. Server cannot step forward while making serve
- 9. Double hits will result in a loss of the point
- 10. A serve or shot that lands outside the court boundaries, passes under or through the net, touches any other obstructions or a player's clothes or body is not allowed
- 11. A player cannot touch the net or its supports while the shuttle is still in play
- 12. The shuttle in play cannot be struck before it crosses the net to the stricker's side of the net
- 13. Players can take one timeout of one minute per set
- 14. If a player fails to show up within 15 minutes after the allotted time of match, a walkover will be given



## **Throwball** [Girls]

- 1. The team shall consist of 7 active players and 3 substitutes.
- 2. The match will be played for the best of 3 set with 15 points for each set.
- 3. Any ball to be released should be released from above the shoulder/shoulder-line only.
- 4. Double touch is not allowed for receiving the service ball.
- 5. A player cannot serve the ball before the referee's whistle and the serve ball cannot touch the net.
- 6. A player cannot jump while serving the ball.
- 7. A player cannot jump while catching the ball, but can while throwing the ball.
- 8. A player must serve the ball within 5 seconds of the whistle and must return the ball within 5 seconds of catching it.
- 9. Player/teams must report 15 minutes prior to the venue. If any team fails to show up within 10 minutes after the allotted time of their match, a walkover will be given.



#### **E-Gaming**

- 1. EA SPORTS FIFA 24 would be played on a PS4 or PS5 depending on availability
- 2. All registered players will play against each other in a single elimination format
- 3. Players can choose any team except for the All Stars teams.
- 4. Custom Formation, Tactics, Instructions are not allowed
- 5. Full Match to be played
- 6. Penalties if match ends in a tie
- 7. Half Time: 5 minutes (16 minute Final)
- 8. Injuries, Handballs, Manual Keeping will be off
- 9. General Rules: Decisions made by officials are final and unchallengeable



## CHESS [Boys / Girls]

Format & Rules:

- 1. Boys & Girls may compete against each other
- 2. Each player will get 10 minutes on the clock with no increment.
- 3. Winner will be chosen according to the point system.
- 4. 5 rounds will take place.
- 5. All FIDE rules will apply.

#### **General Rules for All Games:**

- 1. Decisions made by the officials will be final and unchallengeable
- Any breach of the LA Melange Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action and Learning Alliance reserves the right to use any measures deemed necessary for said action.
- Participants must be dressed in their schools' sports kits and be in possession of their participant ID card at all times
- If a team/ participant does not show up for their scheduled event at the stipulated team, the opposing team/ participant will get a walk over.
